

**Atwood Yacht Club
Cruising Fleet
Racing Rules
2006**

- 1. 2006 handicap is Atwood PHRF. (PHRF-AL)**
- 2. Races start at 1:00 p.m.**
- 3. Skipper's meeting on the porch at 12:00 noon.**
- 4. Four racing divisions:**
 - Racer/Cruisers**
 - Division I Boats 25' and over**
 - Division II Boats under 25'**
 - Division III Catalina 22's**
- 5. The race committee will set courses for each race. Divisions II and III may sail a different or shorter course. All boats will have the same starting line. Each fleet may have its own individual start sequence, starting with Racer/Cruisers, DivI, DivII and DivIII.**
- 6. If there are fewer than 3 boats on the starting line in any of the three divisions, the fleet with less than three boats will sail with the division above them.**
- 7. Chutes prohibited except on a boat where chute serves in lieu of jib, in which case a special PHRF penalty will be assessed. All boats in the Racer/Cruiser fleet may fly chutes without a penalty**
- 8. Finish Status meeting at picnic table on Lower Basin Street one half hour after last boat is in. Awards for each fleet for 1st, 2nd**

and 3rd place finishes are given out at the Sailor's Banquet in November.

- 9. Skipper of boat must be onboard the majority of races, currently set at 5 out of 7 races. Skipper must have a regular crew. If skipper cannot attend a race, a regular crewmember can assume the skipper duties for the missing skipper.**
- 10. \$30.00 fleet social dues as well as a \$10.00 racing fee must be paid in order to race. (\$30 social members, \$40 racing members)**
- 11. Except as herein modified, USYRU rules, as modified by AYC fleet rules apply.**
