**REGATTA INFORMATION**

**ENTRIES:** The Harvest Moon Regatta is open to yachtsmen from any recognized yacht and sailing club. Races will be scheduled for Thistle, Highlander, Lightning, Flying Scot, Laser and Cruising Class boats. The Cruising Class will be sailed in four divisions: Racer-Cruiser I (for example; S2-7.9, J-22/24, Sonar, Ideal 18 and other comparable boats), Jam Fleet II Yachts (25 ft & over), Jam Fleet III Yachts (under 25 ft) and Jam Fleet IV Yachts (Catalina 22 ft). Sunfish Class is restricted to Junior Sailors, age 18 and under. There will be no penalty for flying a spinnaker in Racer-Cruiser Division I; in the other Jam Fleets, there will be a 12 second a mile penalty for flying a spinnaker. A penalty of 6 second per mile will be assessed for any Cruising Class boat using headsails over 155%.

**REGISTRATION FEE:** Paid registration received on or before September 3, 2011 is \$55.00 (\$15.00 for Junior Sailors). Registration received after September 3, 2011 will be \$60.00 (\$20.00 for Junior Sailors). Advanced registration is encouraged. Fee includes racing trophies and social events in connection with the Regatta. At the time of registration, a \$5.00 per yacht refund will be given to those yacht registrants presenting a **U.S. Sailing Membership Card**. (This refund does not apply to Junior Sailors)

**SAFETY:** Boats must comply with all safety requirements prescribed by the State of Ohio (ODNR).

**BERTHING & LAUNCHING:** Assistance will be available for launching all yachts. Ample trailer space is available. A hoist is available for launching One Design Yachts.

**TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded in each Class or Division. Crew prizes will be awarded up to a maximum of three per yacht.

**FOOD SERVICE:** A Saturday and Sunday breakfast buffet is included in the Registration Fee, along with a sack lunch on Saturday. Lunch and Dinner may also be purchased at moderate prices.

**LODGING:** Limited Camping space is available on the Club lawn in front of the parking lot and West of the Pool-house and Racing Shanty. Restrooms and shower facilities are available. Here is a partial list of area accommodations:

From I-77 northbound, exit at Route 39 at New Philadelphia. Follow Route 39 east through Sherrodsville to Route 212. Turn left on Route 212 to Route 542. Turn right on Route 542. The Club is on the left after you pass Atwood Lake Resort. (on the right)

From I-77 Southbound, exit at Route 212 at Bolivar. Turn left and follow Route 212 through Zoar and over the Atwood Dam, At Route 542 turn left. The Club is on the left after you pass Atwood Lake Resort. (on the right)
