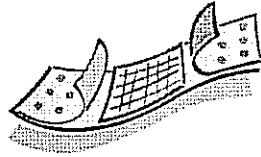
December 31. Thank you to Dan (and Becky) Hershberger, and their committee, for all the hard work organizing, decorating, and overseeing this annual event!
