Again, thanks.

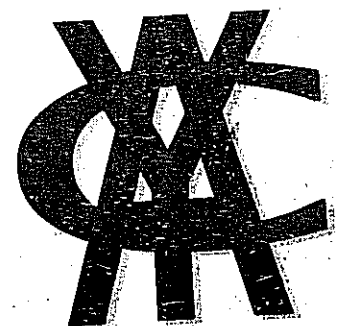

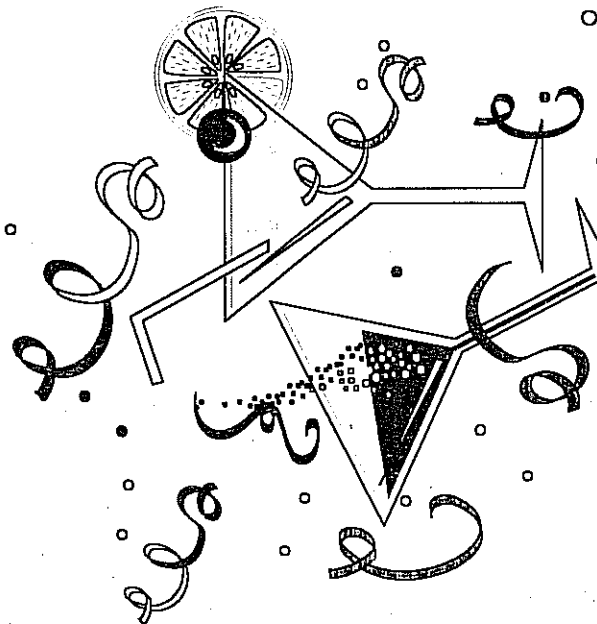
