NOW BEGINS AT NOON.....**

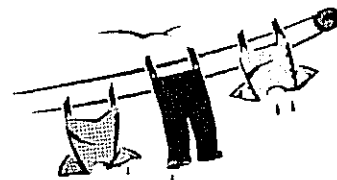
Now that the weather is cooperating, our staff is pleased to take your food and drink orders on the porch – the best "dinning room with a view" anywhere.

**RULES
ATWOOD YACHT CLUB**

1. No **pets** are permitted on the Club grounds at any time.

2. No intoxicating beverages are to be brought to the Club grounds. This is a Club rule and is required to be in compliance with our lease with the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District.

3. No food or beverage is permitted in the Clubhouse or on the porch except that which has been purchased from the Club. Picnic groups are permitted on the porch in bad weather if it does not interfere with other functions.

4. Swimming in the lake is not permitted from the Club shore or docks by order of the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District.

5. All Members having picnics or activities on the Club grounds shall be responsible for properly cleaning up their sites and disposing of all trash.

6. Guest's are not permitted on the Club premises unless in the presence of their host member. The host member is personally responsible for the conduct and actions of their guests. An Active or Senior Member may bring any reasonable number of guests to the Club and a Junior Member may have up to three guests at any one time. Non-Resident members have no guest privileges.

7. Dress Code - For the Lounge and other areas of the Clubhouse: shirts, cover ups and shoes must be worn at all times. For the Dining Room: Full attire excluding bathing suits, cover-ups and bare feet. No wet bathing suits are permitted in any part of the clubhouse.

8. The ladies front powder room is not to be used for changing of clothes. This activity is permitted in the powder room next to the manager's office or the pool room.

9. No one under 21 years of age is permitted in the Lounge.

10. Members are responsible for the proper supervision of children in their care. Children shall not be left unattended, especially in the area of the pool or playground.

11. Members using the swimming pool shall observe pool hours and regulations. Pool Attendants are in charge of enforcement of pool rules and any infractions will be reported to the Board of Trustees for further action.

12. Club Service tickets may be used **ONLY** for food and beverages in the dining room, snack bar, and Lounge. Club Service Tickets may not be used for admission to special events.

13. Club Service Tickets may **NOT** be used for the purpose of tipping. All tipping should be in cash or through the use of credit cards.

14. By Board of Trustees action at the January Meeting of 1996, rule (9) was amended to allow children in the Lounge until 8:00 p.m. Children are not permitted to sit at the bar. They must be in the presence of an adult and the adult must be responsible for their actions.

15. By Board of Trustee action at the September Meeting of 2005, Rule (14) was amended to allow children under the age of sixteen (16) in the Lounge until 8:00 p.m. and those 16 or over but under the age of Twenty-one (21) to be in the Lounge until 9:30 p.m. No individual under the age of (21) is allowed to sit at the bar. Individuals under the age of (21) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and that person will be responsible for their behavior and actions. Active Members under the age of Twenty-One are excluded from these restrictions with the exception of setting at the bar.

16. By the Board of Trustees action at the February meeting of 2006, the Marr Dining Room and the Club Ballroom are designated to be "**SMOKE FREE ZONES**". No smoking shall be permitted in these areas.

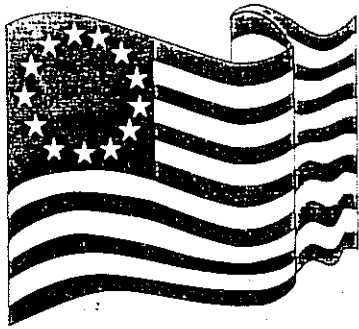
